# **PUBLIC COMMENTS:**

Every agenda for regular meetings shall provide an opportunity for members of the public to directly address the legislative body on any item of interest to the public, before or during the legislative body's consideration of the item, that is within the subject matter jurisdiction of the legislative body, provided that no action shall be taken on any item not appearing on the agenda unless the action is otherwise authorized by subdivision (b) of Section 54954.2. However, the agenda need not provide an opportunity for members of the public to address the legislative body, at a public meeting wherein all interested members of the public were afforded the opportunity to address the committee on the item, before or during the committee's consideration of the item, unless the item has been substantially changed since the committee heard the item, as determined by the legislative body. Every notice for a special meeting shall provide an opportunity for members of the public to directly address the legislative body. A member of the audience engaging in any such conduct shall, at the discretion of the Board President or a majority of the Board, be subject to ejection from the meeting per Gov. Code Sect. 54954.3(c).

## REMOVAL FROM THE SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD ROOM:

Any person who commits the following acts in respect to a meeting of the Arvin Union School District shall be removed from the Board Room per Gov. Code Sect. 54954.3(c).

(a) Disorderly, contemptuous or insolent behavior toward the Board or any member thereof, tending to interrupt the due and orderly course of said meeting;

(b) A breach of the peace, boisterous conduct or violent disturbance, tending to interrupt the due and orderly course of said meeting;

(c) Disobedience of any lawful order of the Board President, which shall include an order to be seated or to refrain from addressing the Board; and

(d) Any other unlawful interference with the due and orderly course of said meeting.

Individuals who require disability-related accommodations or modifications, including auxiliary aids and services, in order to participate in the Board meeting should contact the Superintendent's Office at least two days before the meeting date.
