### **9:00 a.m. Graduation Ceremony - The Fall House**

Graduation will take place on the front lawn of the Fall House facing the mountains. The awarding of diplomas will occur in the traditional manner, and graduates will accept their diploma from the Chair of the Board of Trustees. The event will last approximately 1½ hours.

There will not be assigned seating this year for guests though we do ask that you RSVP using [this link](#) so that we have enough seating for everyone. Every family will have two reserved seats for each graduate. There will be ample seating for additional guests of the graduates in the unreserved area. Designated seating for under formers, faculty and graduates will be clearly marked.

Dress for Graduation is appropriate business attire (Dress pants, Blazer, Button Down Shirt, Tie, Dress Shoes; Dress, Dress Skirt, Dress Pants, Blouse, Dress Shoes).

The event will be held outside, rain or shine. Graduation will be live streamed and recorded. A copy of the edited video will be sent via email to each family in the weeks following graduation.
