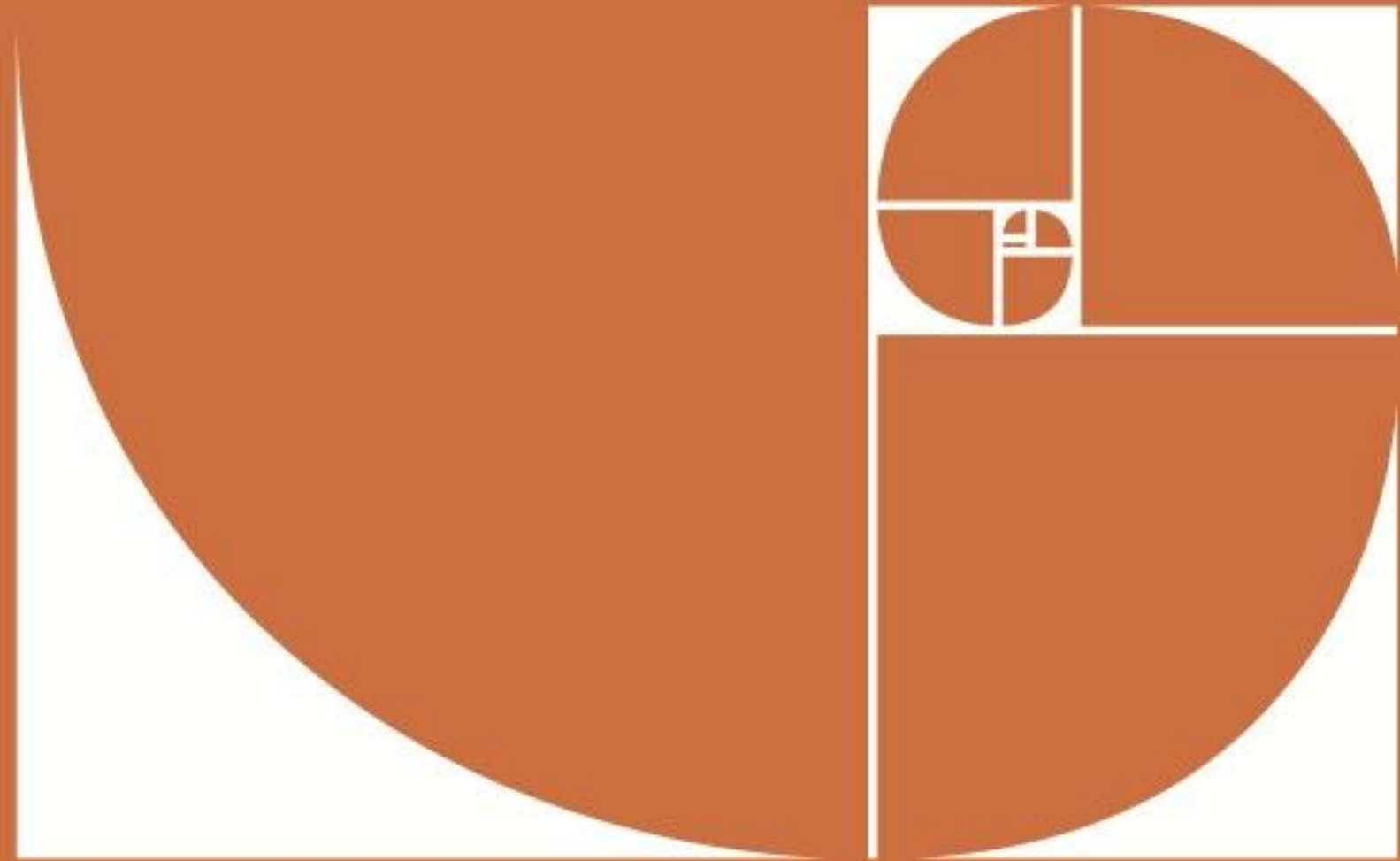

# Note from Ms. Powell

SLCSE Families,

Students in grades 9 and 10 will be taking the Utah Aspire Plus assessment in April. It includes four subtests: reading, English, mathematics, and science. Students will receive predicted ACT score ranges for each subtest, as well as an overall predicted composite ACT score range, therefore it is critical that students take the test seriously and come to school prepared to do their best. The ACT test, taken in 11th grade, is an entrance exam used by most colleges and universities to make admissions decisions.

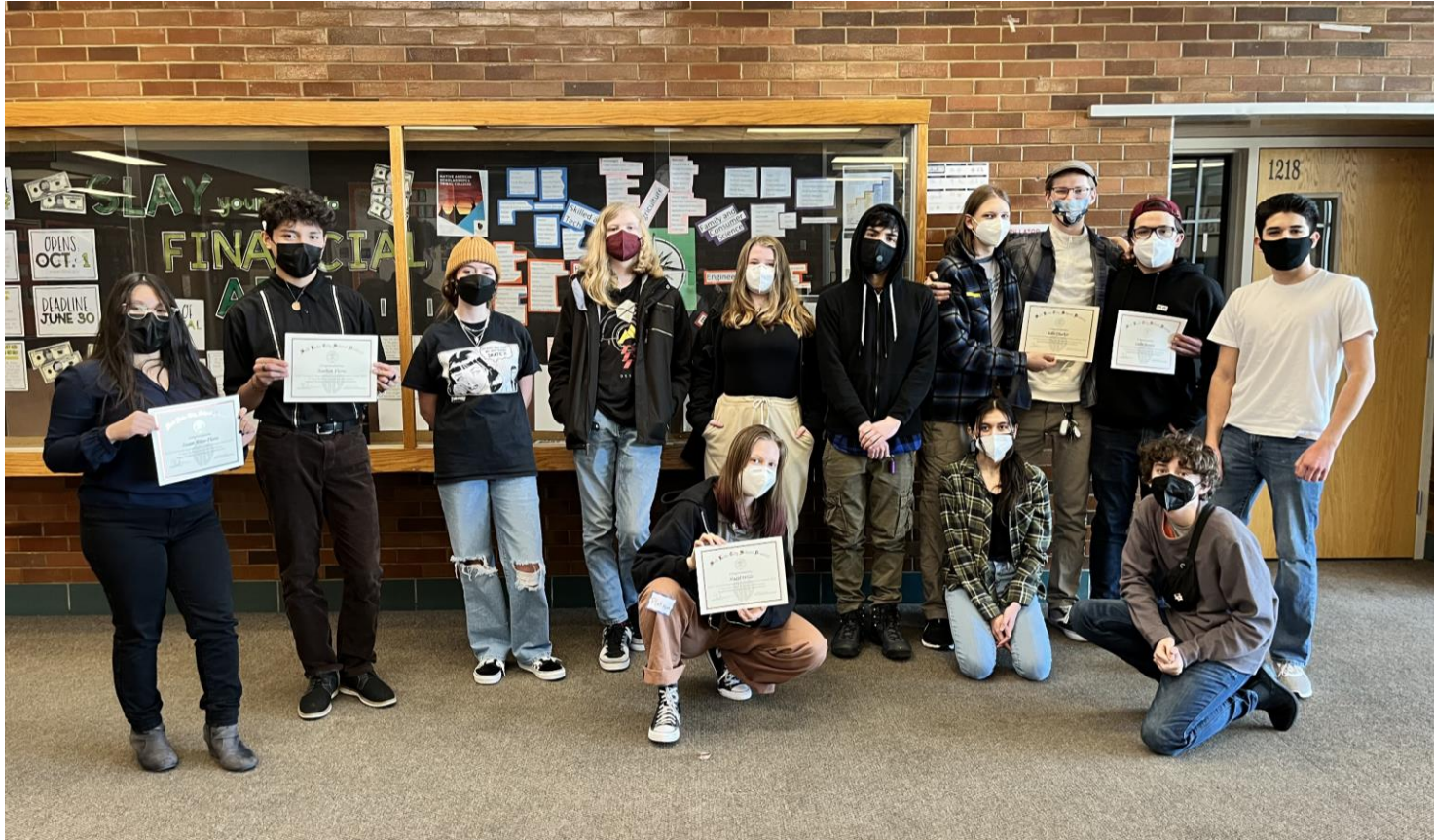

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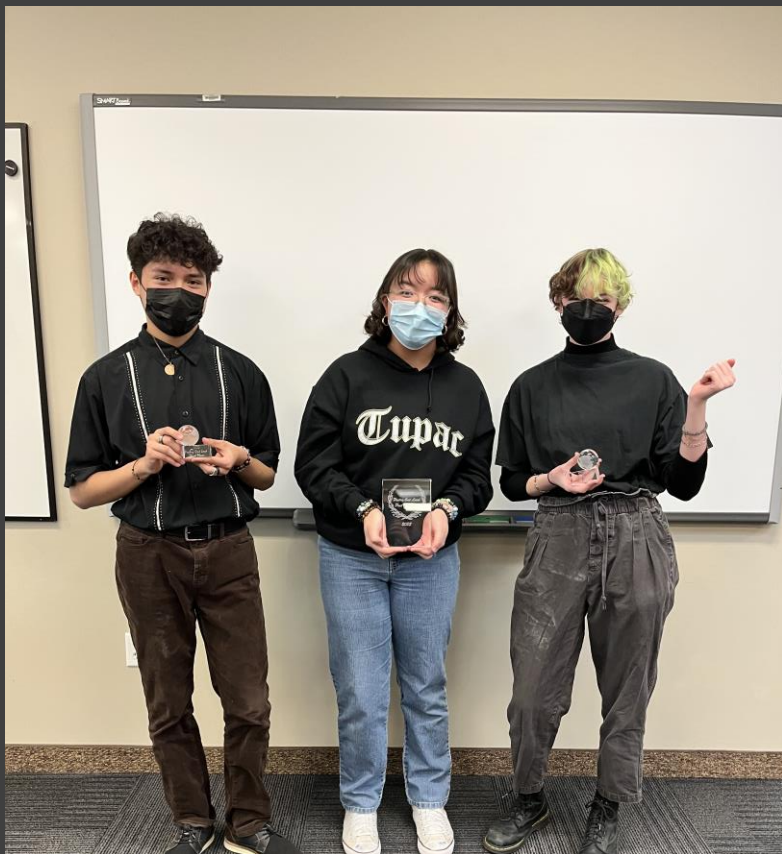

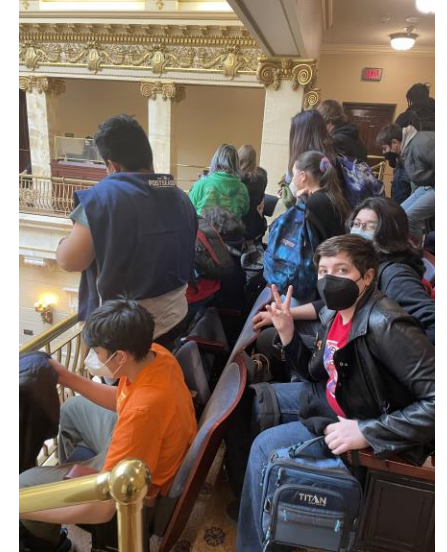
