2. Approve Last Months Minutes

3. Review of Proposed SIP Goals for 2022-23 School Year

**Goal 1:** Increase the % of students performing at a “typical or better progress” on Acadience MOY benchmark.

- The plan is to increase by 3% and reach 69% of the students at or above that goal.
- Planned Budget for reading tutors is \$36,000.

**Goal 2:** Increase the percentage of ELL students making adequate progress on Acadience MOY benchmark testing will increase by 3% from the previous year’s MOY benchmark.

- This sub-group is the lowest on Acadience benchmark reading in the whole school with only 54% to goal at the MOY benchmark.
- Focus is on K-3 students.
- Planned budget ELL tutor, \$10,000.

**Goal 3:** 70% of 4-6 grade students will make “typical or better progress” on the iReady Math EOY benchmark. \*See proposed changes below.

- Budget  
\$2000 STEM Coordinator  
\$1500 Mystery Science  
\$1800 Generation Genius  
\$8000 iReady Licences  
\$2700 Misc. Technology

**Goal 4:** SEL

- The focus will be on students being everyday strong. Students will learn from failure and increase in resilience to move forward. Help students feel safe during normal and necessary separations.
- There will be no budget attached to this goal.

4. Any changes to proposed Goals by committee

- Changes to Goal #3 – increase by 5% percent for “typical or better progress” rather than 70% of all students.

5. Approve Proposed Draft – Committee approved goals as drafted with proposed change to #3 and Mrs. Carmony will update the SIP draft of 2022-2023 goals.

6. Update on Teacher Grant provided through school funds

- \$100 Grant for teachers to use for class – 5 questions will be required for teachers to apply for funds.
