Minutes	Gabriela Ojeda made a motion to approve the minutes as read. Patricia Pantoja seconded the motion, and the minutes were approved unanimously.
Public Comment	The floor was opened for public comment on items not on the agenda. No public comment.
Welcoming Activity	Attendees were given a couple of minutes to take grade 3 & 5 math Practice Test. The Practice Test is posted on the CAASPP.org portal.
Uniform Input	Georgia Rhett shared the uniform policy. Attendees shared their input from the 4 school sites. Input from group clearly identified they would like to add school sports uniforms, light color denim and maintain same color uniform colors. However, they would like to remove cargo pants from the uniform policy. A concern was raised regarding enforcement of the policy.
ConApp	Georgia Rhett presented a PowerPoint and reviewed Title I, II and III of the Consolidated Application for Funding. This application is used to distribute funds from federal programs to school districts. Each of the major components was included in the review, as well as a breakdown by school site. Emma Perez made a motion to approve the ConApp. Gabriela Ojeda seconded the motion and the ConApp was approved.
Haven Drive Electives	Mr. Gutierrez shared the elective course packet sheet and encouraged parents to turn in to school as soon as possible. He shared how pleased he was to introduce a journalism class as a new elective.
State Testing	Jennifer Johnson shared the testing window for the English Language Proficiency Assessment for California (ELPAC) testing. She also announced the ELPAC is taking place of the California English Language Development Test (CELDT). Georgia Rhett shared a parent guide to the Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments. She encouraged parents to log in with their students and take the practice test to see the different types of questions.
Safety Plan Highlights	Magdalena Hernandez, Thomas York, Lupe Calderon and Calletano Gutierrez briefed attendees on the focus on school climate, school safety and strategies at each school site. Topics of mutual interest among the schools included monthly drills, AVID, PBIS, SSA, parent workshops and attendance incentives.
LCAP Input & Data Review	An overview of district action steps was distributed for review and input was tabled for the March meeting.
