### **School Improvement Plan:**

Mrs. Killpack reviewed 2022-2023 SIP goals. Mrs. Killpack clarified questions regarding SEL activities and incentives. Examples of past activities and incentives were given. Questions regarding the role of a school counselor and how the school would use a full-time counselor were discussed. A full-time counselor will most likely cost \$50,000. Mr. Foutz and Mr. Christensen are in support of having a full-time counselor. If funding down the road is not available for a full-time counselor, Mrs. Killpack discussed options.

Money from the 2021-2022 was carried over to help cover the cost of a full-time counselor. Mrs. Killpack will send out what was allocated in funding.
