Uniform Update for 2022-2023 School Year

For the 2022-2023 school year, Herron-Riverside High School will resume the requirement for uniform pants with the school logo. Pants with the updated HRHS logo or the Riverside "R" logo will be allowed. The school skort from SchoolBelles will also be allowed for uniform bottoms

Other items of our school uniform will remain the same. Scholars must wear a plain white or navy blue polo shirt every day to school with or without a school logo. Scholars may wear outerwear that is purchased from SchoolBelles with the school logo (new or old) or a plain, navy crewneck sweatshirt without the school logo. Students must wear shoes with backs and only a clear backpack is allowed to be carried throughout the school day from class to class. Please refer to the school handbook for more details.






Geometry Students Scale Project

Students in geometry have been learning about similar figures, scale factor, and proportions in images that are dilated. They culminated the unit with a project where they chose a college that they want to attend and traced the logo onto a small graph. Then, they used their knowledge of scale factors and proportions to create a dilated version of their logo, minimizing the extra white space on their larger graph paper.













ACP Biology Students "Make" Insulin

Students in Dr. Cruz's ACP Biology class acted as molecular scissors this week, using restriction enzymes to create a recombinant DNA plasmid. The goal was to create a plasmid containing the Insulin gene with antibiotic resistance to select the proper bacteria. Dr. Cruz said, "We hope to move on from paper models to transform real E. Coli bacteria!"







Indiana Junior Classical League State Convention

Mr. Kevin Harris, Benjamin Meyer, Maya Johnson, Amelie Soline (Herron-Riverside High School scholars) and Sophia Madrazo (Herron High School) attended the Indiana Junior Classical League (IJCL) State Convention last month. IJCL helps provide an avenue for our scholars who develop a passion for Latin and Classical cultures to dive even deeper into their education.

The National Junior Classical League is an organization of junior high and high school students, composed of local and state chapters made up of students of Latin and classical humanities, and is the largest classical organization in the world today. Its purpose is to encourage an interest in and an appreciation of the language, literature, and culture of ancient Greece and Rome and to give students some understanding of the debt of their own culture to that of classical antiquity.

The Herron Classical Schools chapter also received multiple awards:

- 2nd place overall in small school category; This means that all the awards we won as individuals and as a group added up to the 2nd most in the small school category.
- 2nd place in the Advanced level, state Certamen competition; this is an academic competition, like Quizbowl. The Advanced team was Benjamin, Maya and Sophia.
- Sophia won an Individual Academic Testing Achievement Award, meaning she was one of the top scorers overall in individual academic testing.
- Benjamin won an Individual Creative Arts Achievement Award and an Individual Graphic Arts Achievement Award, meaning he was one of the top scorers in both Creative Arts competitions and Graphic Arts competitions.
















Get your tickets to Movie Night!
