

# ORDER DECLARING RESULT OF SPECIAL ELECTION 1924

On this the 28th day of January, 1974, the Commissioners' Court of Collin County, Texas, convened in Special session at the regular meeting place in the Courthouse in McKinney, Texas, with the following members present, to-wit:

constituting a quorum, and among other proceedings passed the following order:

There came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 26th day of January, 1974, in Collin County, Texas,

upon the proposition as set forth in the Order of Special Election calling said election and it appearing that said election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made, and that there were cast at said election \_\_\_\_\_ valid and legal votes, of which number there were cast:

- "FOR" Conversion of Community Rural High School District  
to Community Independent School District. ..... 68 votes
- "AGAINST" Conversion of Community Rural High School District  
to Community Independent School District. ..... 4 votes

IT IS THEREFORE FOUND, DECLARED AND SO ORDERED by the Commissioners' Court of Collin County, Texas, that a two-thirds <sup>(1)</sup> majority of the legally qualified property taxpaying <sup>(2)</sup> voters who owned taxable property in said County and who had duly rendered the same for taxation, <sup>(2)</sup> voting at said election, voted \_\_\_\_\_ <sup>(3)</sup> the proposition and that therefore said proposition as set out in the Order of Special Election adopted by this court is declared to have been passed<sup>(4)</sup>.

1. Strike the word "two-thirds" if only a simple majority is required.
2. If the only requirement for voting was that the voter be a qualified voter strike out the words — "property taxpaying" — "who owned taxable property" — "and who had duly rendered the same for taxation."
3. If election carried, place in this blank the words "in favor of." If election failed to carry, strike the word "voted" preceding this blank and place in the blank the words "failed to vote for."
4. If election failed to carry, strike out the words "been passed" and insert word "failed."
