

IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT COLOR CHOICE:

The full color logos should be used in all electronic/digital material. The full color logos consist of blue, gold, white and silver in the arrow and full logo. Acceptable background colors for the full color logos are royal blue, white, black, grey and silver. Use on any other background color must be approved by CISD Public Relations Department. The full color logos are the preferred version to be used on all print, embroidery and facilities applications. For a more cost effecient option, two color graphics may use blue/gold on white or grey, white/gold on royal blue or black OR blue/white on gold or grey. Single color graphics may only be used in the following combinations: blue on white/grey/gold OR white on blue, dark grey, black OR gold on blue. Do not use gold on white/light grey or white on gold.
