- **Level of achievement- Distinguished vs non distinguished**
- **Credits with certain classes (attendance and grades matter)**
- **At least one Endorsement which can be earned through your program of study**
- **4 non credit bearing requirements (indicators)**



# ***CREDIT BASICS***

- **At least 26 credits**
- **4 of each Core Class**
- **2 Foreign Languages (must be the same)**
- **1 PE credit**
- **1 Fine Art credit (must be the same for the entire year)**
- **6 electives (includes your program of study)**

**Currently, you have the opportunity to earn 32 credits in high school, so you can study multiple programs or electives**

# ***WHAT IS PRIDE PREP?***



- **Begins in 9th grade**
- **Partnership between TAMUC & CISD**
- **Selective, dual credit collegiate preparation program**
- **Students can take up to thirty-six hours of college credit beginning in 9<sup>th</sup> grade**
- **Classes take place at Community High School for 9th & 10th students. Students are transported to TAMUC for classes their 11th & 12th grade year. ( Monday, Wednesday, and Friday beginning at 7:20am)**

# **WHAT IS PTECH?** at Community High School

## ***PATHWAYS IN TECHNOLOGY EARLY COLLEGE PROGRAM***

- **Begins in 9th grade**
- **Selective, dual credit collegiate preparation program for students interested in pursuing a career in Construction or IT**
- **“School within a school” that provides students with a seamless path from high school, to post-secondary education, to employment**
- **Students can earn up to 60 hours of college credit, an industry certification, and an associate's degree while attending high school**



# ***COMMITMENT & EXIT POINTS***

- Students commit to completing the program with a goal of an industry certification, level 1 or 2 certificate, and/or an associates degree
- Multiple exit points leading to a post-secondary path or immediate employment
