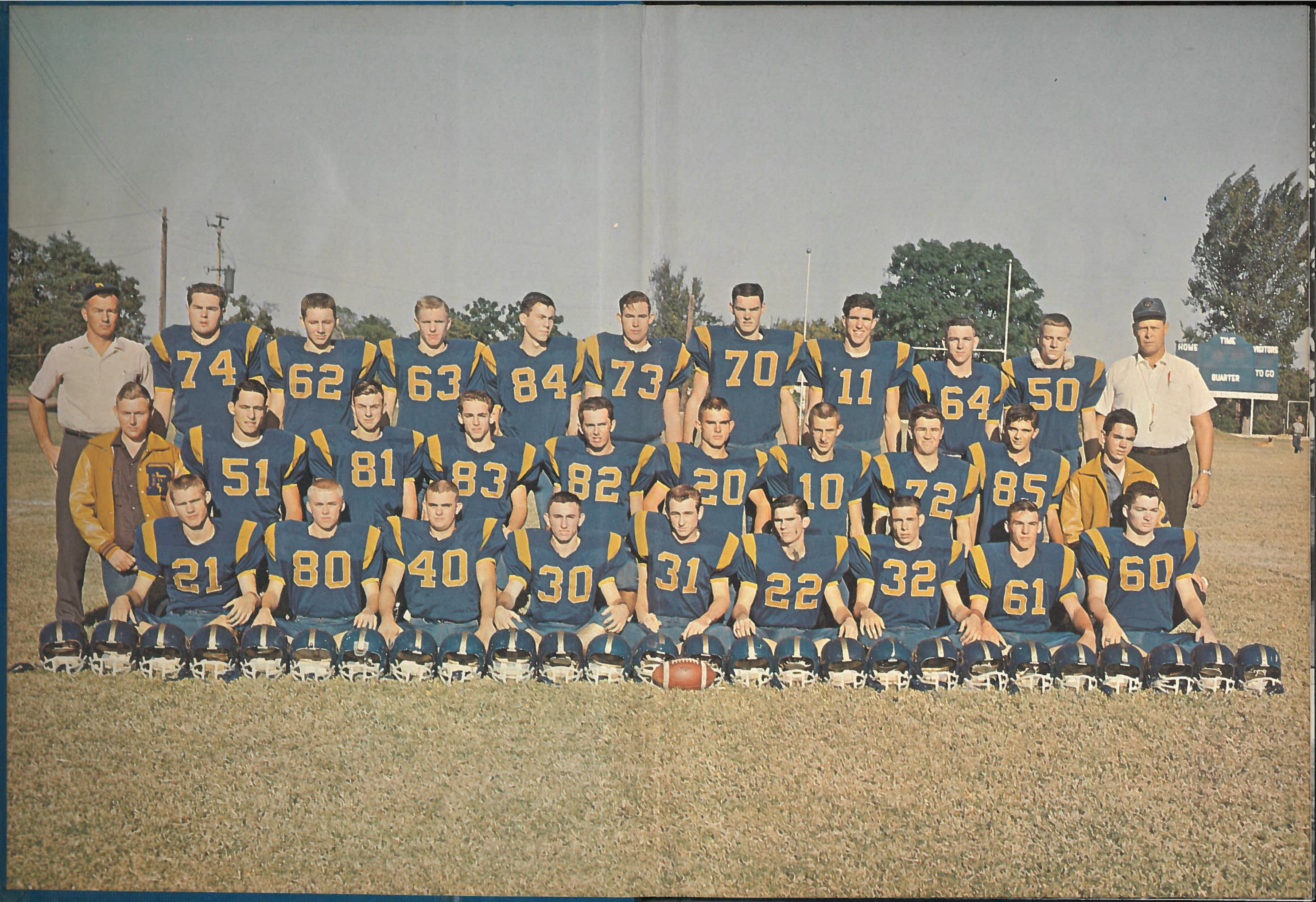

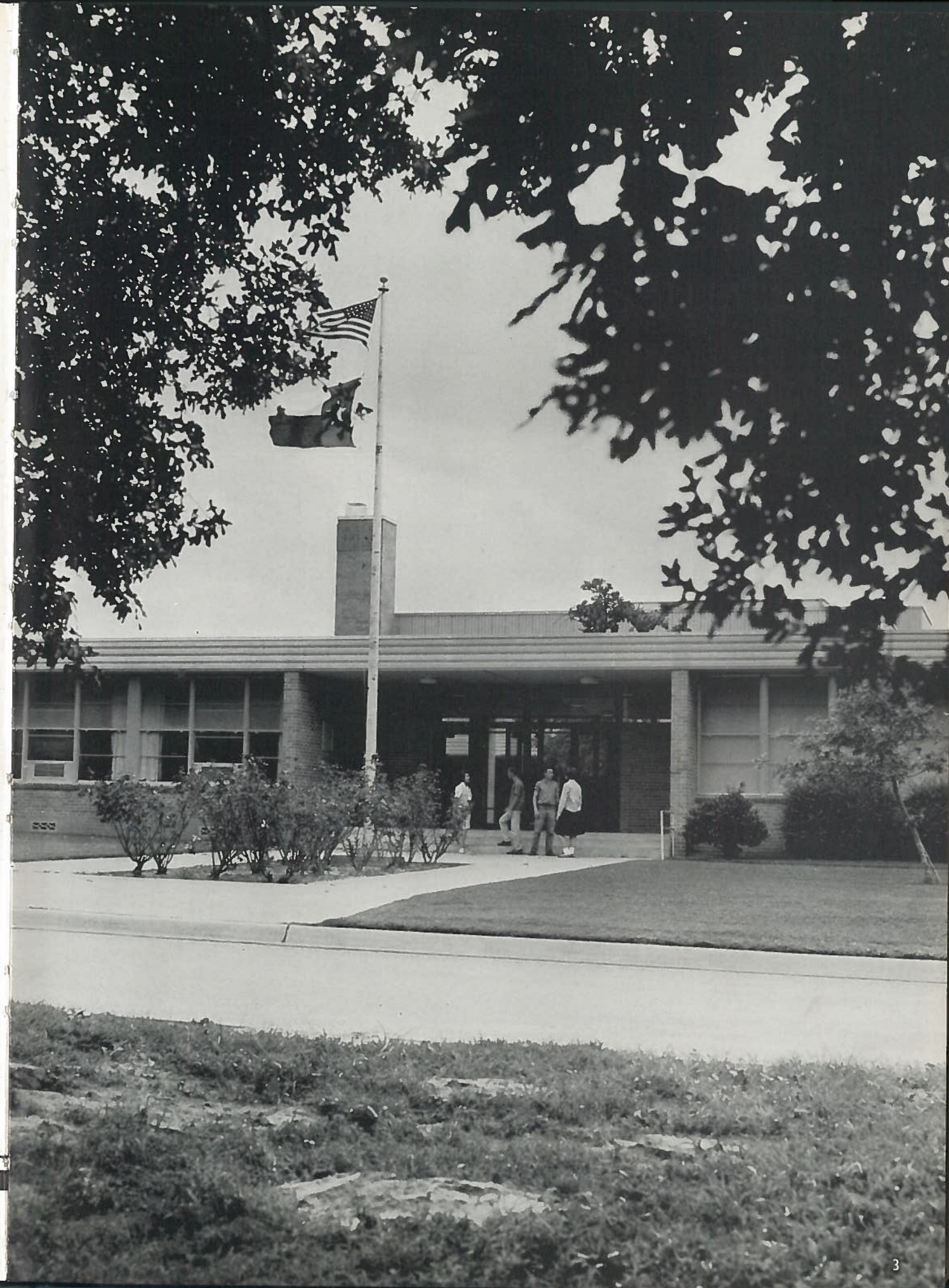
FOREWORD

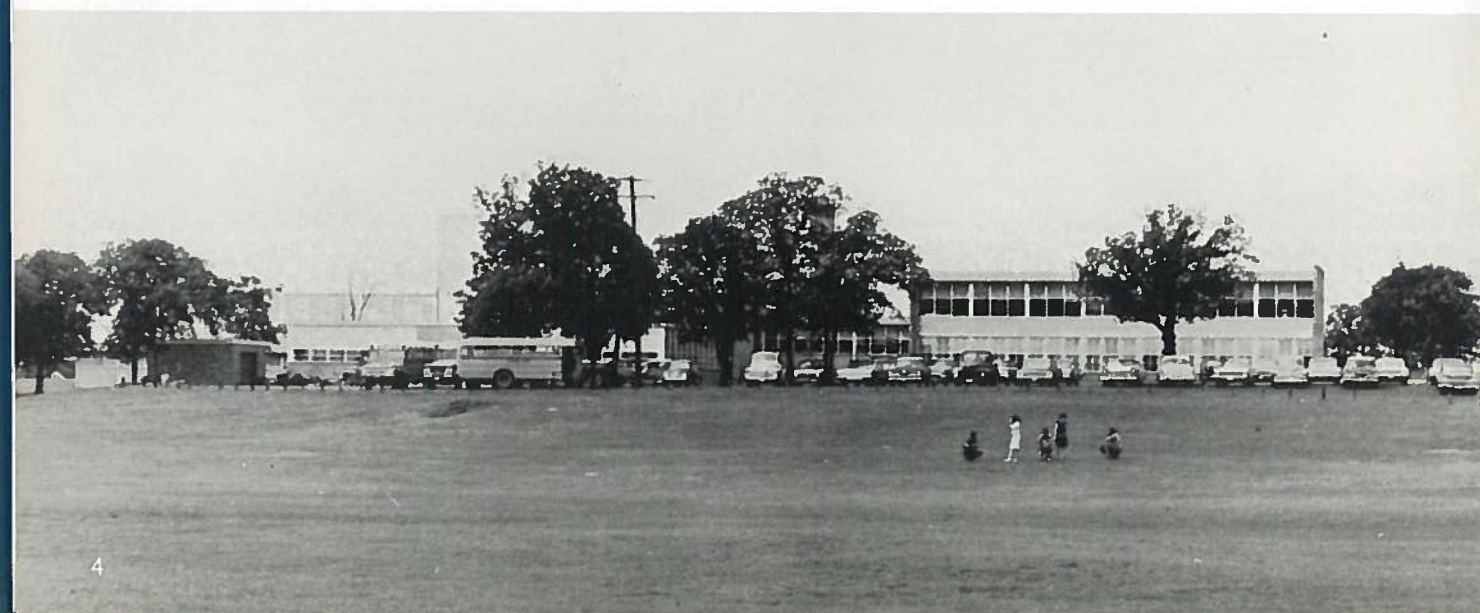
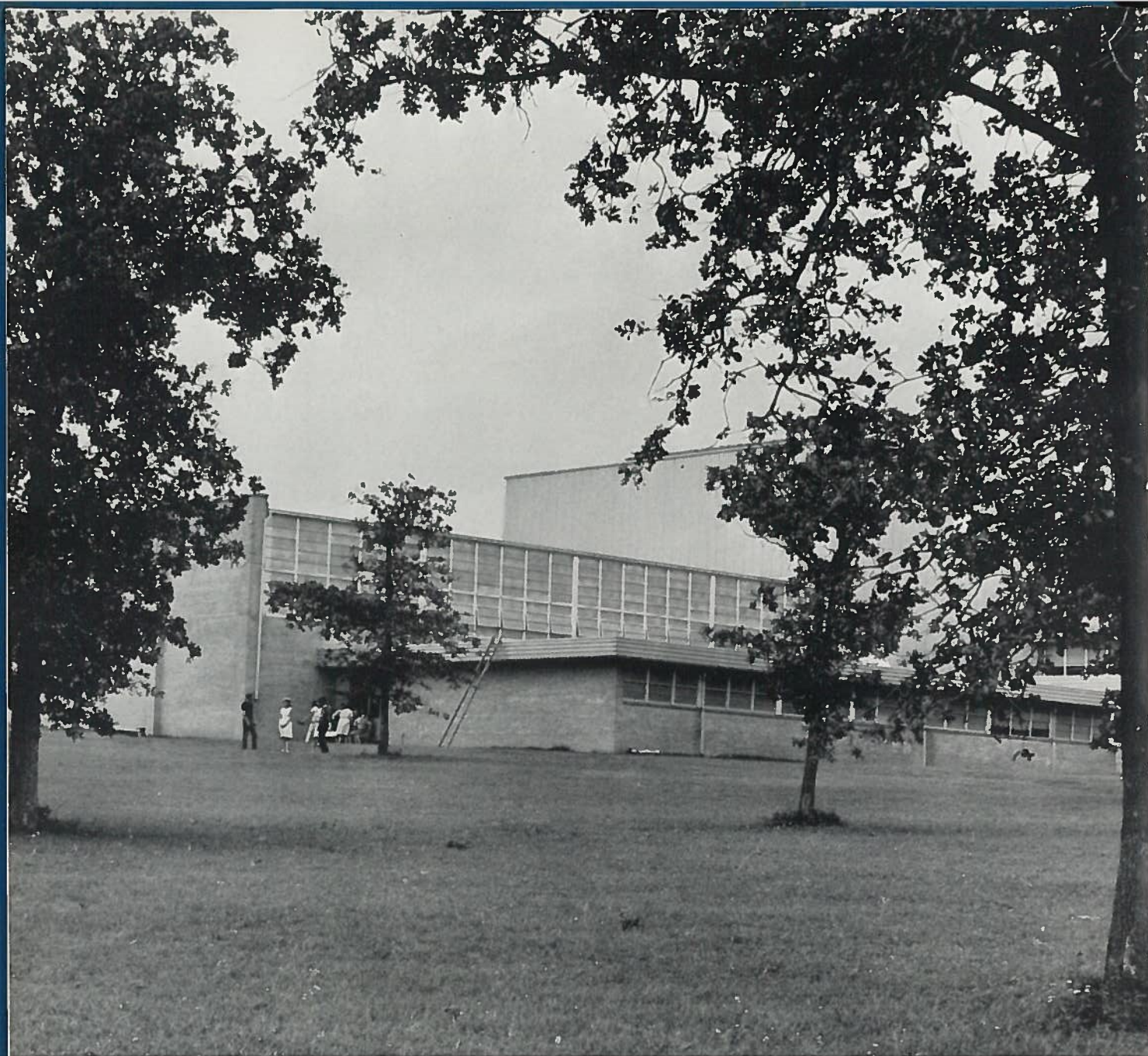
The 1964-65 school year for the Rockdale Public School system has been most eventful and a highly successful one from the standpoint of group and individual accomplishment.

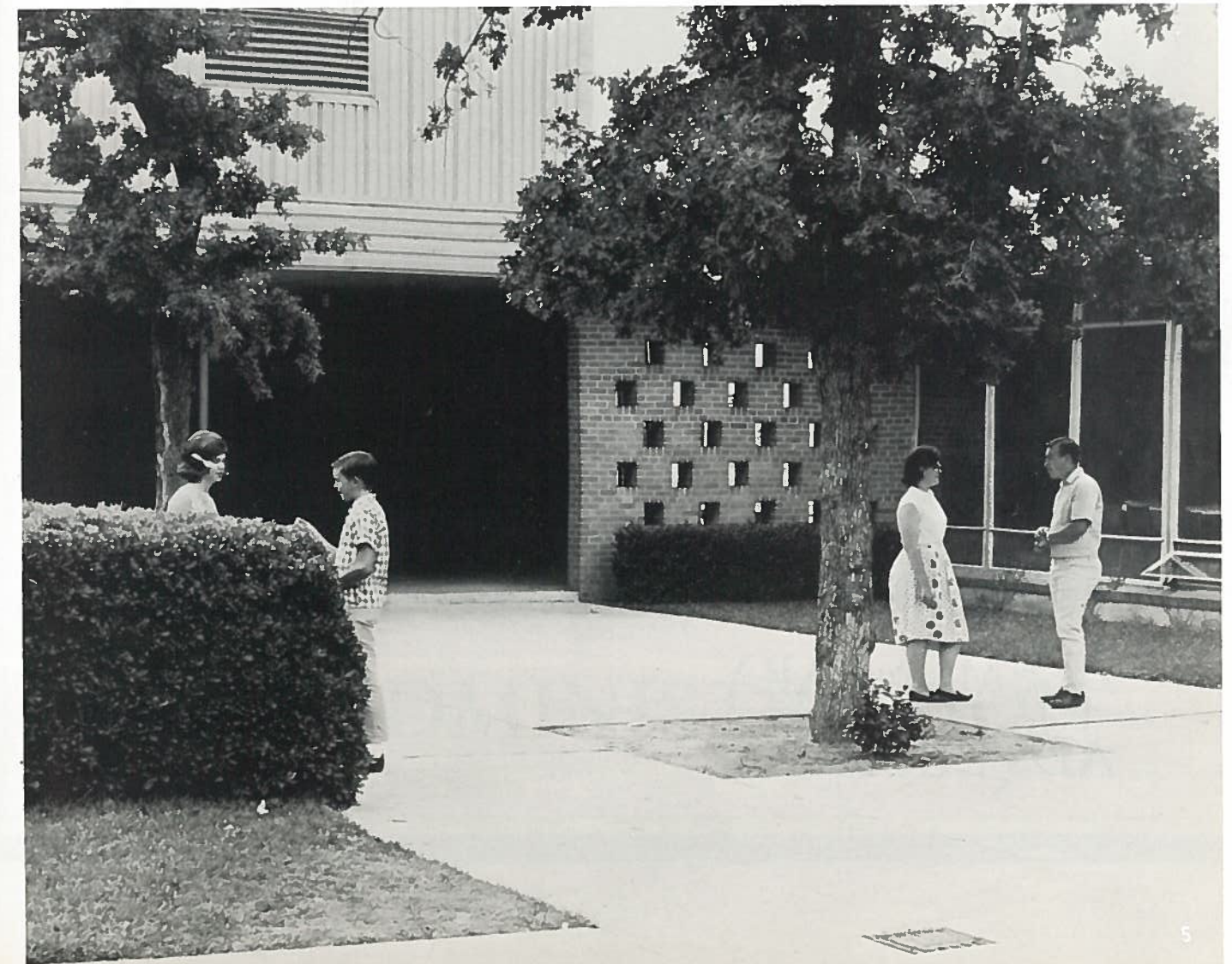
It is always a challenge to capture in pictures the spirit of these occasions as they take place. It is the hope of the annual staff that this challenge has been met successfully.

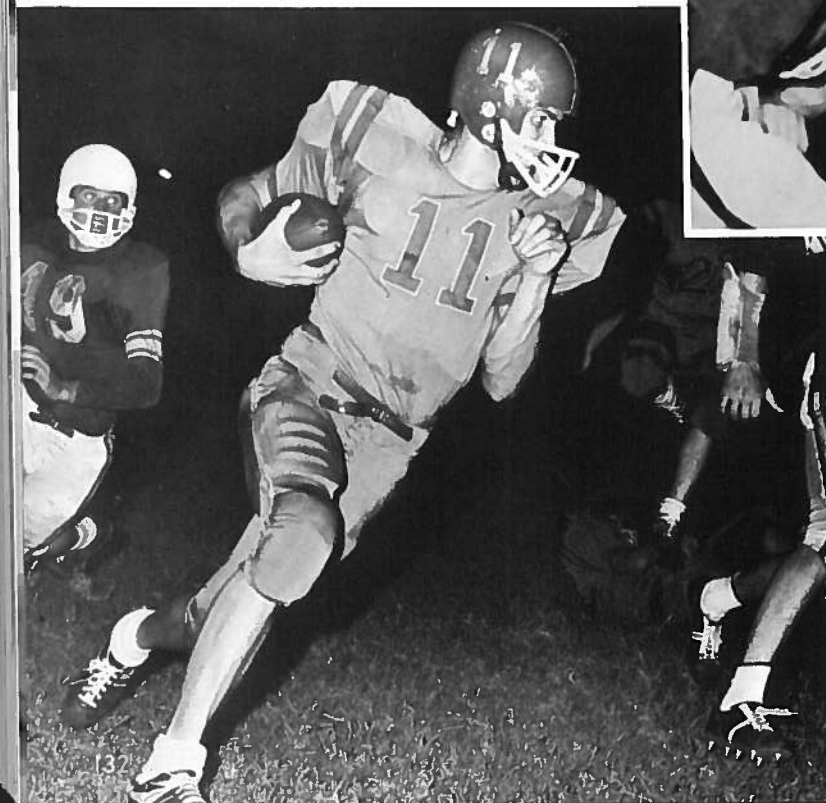

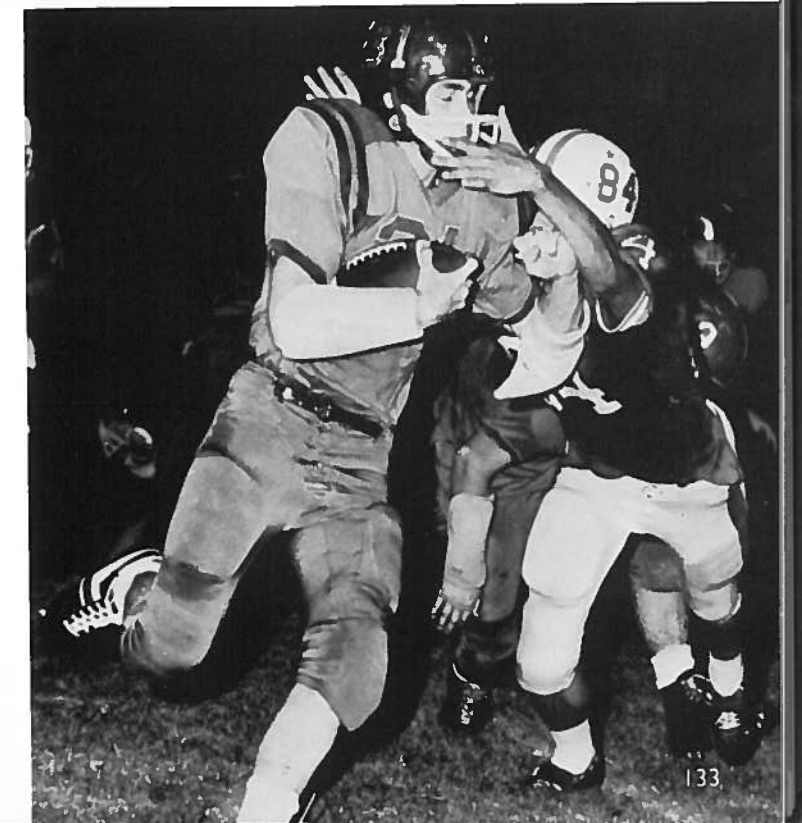
