Acceptable Use Policy
Student Agreement grades 9-12

In general, "acceptable use" means that a student is required to use technology resources in a manner that:

- respects the values of the Catholic Church;
- is related to classwork and has an educational purpose;
- is legal and ethical (including avoiding plagiarism);
- avoids harm to any person or property;
- avoids accessing or transmitting harmful or inappropriate material;
- is consistent with all school rules, specifically the honor code.

Consequences:

Any attempt to violate this agreement could result in the following consequences – regardless of the success or failure of the attempt:

- loss of access to equipment;
- notification to law enforcement;
- additional disciplinary action deemed appropriate by XHS administration (e.g., detention, suspension, etc.);
- repayment of any damage caused by a student or other user.
