<p>Brooke Haag was appointed to replace Jennifer Johnson as a Council Member.</p>	<p>Principal T.J. Naylor appointed Brooke Haag as new staff council member.</p>
<p>Ashley Graves spoke about recent racist occurrences at the Junior High per the request of former Stewart parent.</p>	<p>Robyn emphasized the need to continue to educate. All recognized that racism is occurring in our community. There is a new website on the District page where you can report racist occurrences. Principal Naylor recognized that there is some negative feedback around the “No More, Not Here” campaign but we are trying to change behavior and that is always met with resistance, we just keep going and make sure kids feel safe at our schools.</p>
<p>Discussion and final planning on the Digital Safety and STEAM Night event on April 28th</p>	<p>Brooke Haag has arranged for three food trucks and snow cone truck. All vendors have been assigned rooms and teacher volunteers have been recruited. Wristbands have been ordered. They will be handed out to kids who complete attendance to ICAC presentation. Brek Noice will be taking Brooke’s responsibilities the night of the event since Brooke will be out of town.</p> <p>Community Council room will address Responsible Gaming. Gina Hirst will make posters regarding this and commitment pages for kids to sign. There will be Nintendo switches set up for kids to play Mario Kart upon signing. Vendors will start setting up at 4 pm so Community Council Members should plan on arriving then to set up room.</p> <p>Julianne Zollinger, Robyn Huff and anyone else available will meet on Monday at 1:15 to practice setting up Nintendo Switches with the schools technology specialist.</p>

Principal Naylor discussed the proposed Land Trust Plan and the budget for the TSSP funds.	<p>With remaining 2021-2022 funds (\$31,000 total) council unanimously approved using \$12,000 for teacher stipends upon completion of the District 'Letters' program and \$13,000 for audio updates in classroom and gym. \$6,000 remains and will be rolled-over for next year. Julianne motioned, Sean seconded, all voted in favor.</p> <p>Principal Naylor than discussed the upcoming TSSP goals, action steps, and budget:</p> <p>Math Goal: proficiency to increase from 44% to 48% - hiring a full-time Math Coach and purchasing of new ForeFront software to enable middle of year progress tracking for 4th-6th grade.</p> <p>Language Arts Goal: proficiency to increase from 65% to 68% using TA's and Student Assistant Team to support struggling students.</p> <p>With roll over money TSSP budget total is \$86,500.81 will be used to fund TA's salaries, purchase software/technology programs, math coach salary, and purchase of Move the World and ForeFront.</p> <p>Julianne motioned to adopt these goals, action plans, and budget. Sean seconded. All presented voted in favor. Passed with unanimous vote.</p>
