KEY TAKEAWAYS

Our board meeting agendas often include many items for discussion. While you will always be able to review the agenda, meeting minutes and video recordings of these meetings on [our Board webpage](#), this Board Bulletin provides key takeaways for our Stevenson community.

1 On Monday evening, faculty from the Mathematics Division shared information about their SEL journey with students. Data from the Student Voice Survey in the fall of 2019 showed that only 64% of students in Mathematics classes responded favorably to feeling like they belong in the classroom. The faculty implemented action steps — such as group activities in which students must master a Mathematics concept and share their learning with other students — that would give students the opportunity to build connections and contribute to/benefit from their peers' learning.

The return of students to in-person learning in the classroom has helped students re-engage in these important connections and collaborate with their peers. Compared to the fall of 2019, the percentage of Mathematics students who feel like they belong in the classroom increased significantly from 64% to 77%, as of this spring. Faculty shared their plans to build on this success in the years to come.

2 The Board of Education has also approved the three-year calendars for 2023-2024; 2024-2025; and 2025-2026. Members also approved the revised calendar for 2022-2023, which was originally approved on Nov. 15, 2021. A non-school day was added for Wednesday, Nov. 23, 2022, in exchange for a student attendance day on Friday, May 26, 2023.
