Ballet technique will be taught using Vaganova technique for developing a solid ballet technique with emphasis on understanding correct body placement, proper use of turn out, coordination of the upper body (epaulement), and use of arms (port de bras).

Lyrical dance is a style that combines ballet and jazz dancing techniques. It is performed to music with lyrics so that it inspires expression of strong emotions the choreographer feels from the lyrics of the song. This is a good style to mix with ballet in order to use our dance as worship.

Technique is taught with creative and fun exercises to keep the student engaged. Creative Movement is also used as a means of self expression.
