## **Covid restrictions**

Until informed otherwise schools will continue to operate under their specific Covid risk assessments, as the legislation continues to require that businesses, organisations and workplaces put in place reasonable measures to reduce the risk of spreading the virus. Our schools continue to monitor and review these on a regular basis, and are taking proportionate responses based on local circumstances, to balance the need for face-to-face learning, and keeping our schools safe.

You can help us to continue to disrupt the transmission of the virus by:

- self-isolating when you feel unwell
- wearing masks in crowded places
- keeping up to date with your vaccinations.

Continuing with protective behaviours is important and will help to minimise exposure to and spread of Covid-19, as well as other respiratory infections and other diseases.

If you have any of the main symptoms of Covid-19, you should self-isolate and take a lateral flow test (LFT). You can order LFTs online at www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests or call 119 between 7am and 11pm (calls are free).

The main symptoms of Covid-19 continue to be:

- a high temperature
- a continuous cough
- loss or change of taste or smell.

The next few months will see further work in transitioning to Welsh Government's Living with Covid strategy, and we will continue to do everything we can to keep learners in the classroom, and to keep our schools safe. We are grateful for your ongoing support and will continue to provide updates as they become available. Encouraging good school attendance remains a key priority during the summer term.

No application is necessary. Eligible families will continue to receive BACS payments direct to their bank accounts for the holiday periods up to and including the summer 2022 school holiday period.

# Uniform:


