Process-who are we and what do we do?

Advises the Superintendent in establishing and reviewing the District's educational goals, objectives, and major district-wide classroom instructional programs.

Duties of the Committee

Analyze district data

Analyze the comprehensive needs assessment

Evaluate district-wide staff development needs

Revise the District Improvement plan and make recommendations to the Superintendent and the Board of Trustees.

4 Goals of the 60x30 TX Plan

- The overarching goal 60x30-At least 60 percent of Texans ages 25-34 will have a certificate or degree.
- Completion- At least 550,000 students in 2030 will complete a certificate, associates, bachelor's, or master's from an institution of higher education.
- Marketable skills- All graduates in Texas public institutions of higher education will have completed programs with identified marketable skills.
- Student debt- Undergraduate student loan debt will not exceed 60% of first-year wages for graduates of Texas public institutions.

- Program Evaluation
- CNA
- District/Campus Improvement Plan

Identify and Gather Data

- **Indicators**

Demographics, Student Achievement, School Culture & Climate, Staff Quality, Recruitment, & Retention, Curriculum, Instruction, & Assessment, Family & Community Engagement, School Organization, and Technology

- **Data Sources**

Surveys, State and Local Assessments, Discipline, Attendance, Graduation rates, Teacher retention, Safe schools, Mobility rates, and perceptual surveys.
