

# Respectful, Responsible, and Safe Index Card Game (For all settings)

Give each student three index cards.

The cards are color coded to help students with reading difficulties.

- One card has the words **Be Respectful** written on it in blue.
- One card has the words **Act Responsible** written on it in red.
- One card has the words **Care About Safety** written on it in green.

Put a poster on the board with the words in a list:

- \* **Be Respectful** (in blue)
- \* **Act Responsible** (in red)
- \* **Care About safety** (in green)

Play a guessing game.

e.g., What type of rule is:

- \* Listen politely (Respectful)
- \* Follow directions (responsible)
- \* 6 on floor (safety)

After you state the rule, have the students hold up the card corresponding to the correct category. After the students understand the game, let each student have a turn to recite a rule and the other students guess the category.

This game can be played for the classroom and the nonclassroom settings (bathroom, playground, etc.)
