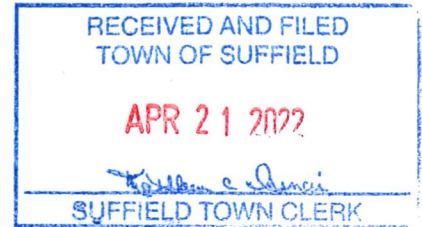


**SUFFIELD CONSERVATION COMMISSION
MEETING MINUTES
MEETING OF TUESDAY, APRIL 12, 2022**

CALL MEETING TO ORDER- 7:00 P.M.

Chairman Christian called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. Consultant Morris read the agenda. Alternate member Elmore shall be voting a member in place of Commissioner Krar who was not present.

PLAN ACCEPTANCE:

Permit #1693 – Breezy Way Farm (owner) – 6-Lot Subdivision – Mountain Road. This property is located on the north side of Mountain Road, nearest intersection being North Grand Street. Assessor’s Map 17H, Block 23, Lot 65B.

Chairman Christian recused himself for a conflict of interest on this application. Vice Chairman Neilson took over as chairperson and appointed Alternate Commissioner McCue as a voting member in place of Chairman Christian.

Consultant Morris presented the application for a 6-lot subdivision on Mountain Road. The application is complete and is on the agenda for acceptance. After a brief discussion, Commissioner Elmore made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McCue to accept the application and set a public hearing date of May 10, 2022, at 7:30 P.M. The motion was carried unanimously.

Chairman Christian took over the meeting as Chairperson. Commissioner McCue will now be a voting member in place of Commissioner Noble who was not present.

CONSULTANT'S REPORT:

Consultant Morris presented a preliminary plan for construction of a single family home and barn on the corner of Thrall Avenue and East Street. The site was previously approved for a 9 lot subdivision. After discussion, Consultant Morris shall research whether this would be a new application or can be handled under an amendment of the original approval.

Vice Chairman Neilson updated the Commission regarding replacing the two foot bridges at Stony Brooke Park. After doing some research it seems that the use of bar joists for construction of the new bridges would be the best option considering their remote location. This will be discussed again at the next meeting with the Parks Superintendent.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE MARCH 22, 2022 MEETING OF THE COMMISSION

Vice Chairman Neilson made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Reilly to approve the minutes as written. The motion carried unanimously.
