- Elec. sub-contractor is behind schedule; Lead time for impact resistant glass has delayed the project; Project is scheduled to be completed in Q4 2021
- OSF Overhead and Final Inspections were approved in August; Teachers returned on August 12<sup>th</sup>
- Fire Riser Pump Room CD's are scheduled to be issued week of Aug. 30th; HGR to provide GMP Proposal within 2-weeks; Team is confirming what additional permitting may be required
- HGR and Electrical sub-contractor are finalizing schedule to complete remaining items
- HVAC Update: 4 compressors are being replaced in WSHP units; Cooling Tower #2 is scheduled to be operational by the end of October
- Remaining furniture from 3 manufacturers continue to be reported as "back-ordered"; BCSD continues to monitor to obtain updated shipment dates
- Mobile classrooms have been relocated to HHIMS
- The connector will be turned over in the fall of 2021; Extensive delays have been experienced due to lead time for impact resistant glass

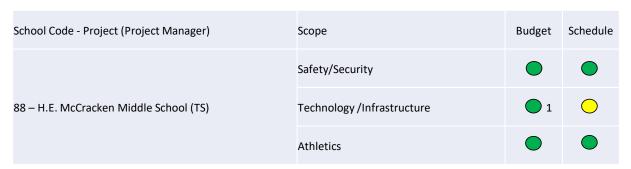

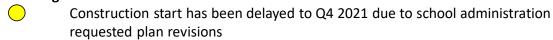
