- 90% of sprinkler heads have been installed; Fire riser is 90% complete; The engineer of Record has submitted plan changes that add a fire riser and fire pump for the sprinkler system due to recent flow test taken from hydrants around the school; HGR is pricing and believes there is enough funding in Construction Contingency; This work has not been scheduled
- Condenser units for Cooler and Freezer are to be installed Week of August 2nd
- HVAC start-up is scheduled to be completed by August 9th
- Furniture has been built and installed in all but 3 offices
- Mobile relocation delayed until August due to poor weather the week of July 26th
- The connector will be turned over in the fall of 2021

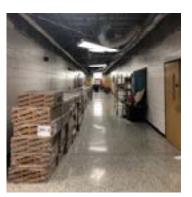

 - * Board Approval of RSIA Early Steel Package on August 3rd will Increase Encumbered & Paid To Date Figure to \$172.8M (50.15%)
 - o Time August is the 20th Month of the 48 Month Program (41.67%)



Significant Events:

- Since the Program Began, Construction Market Changes Have Occurred
 - o COVID Pandemic
 - Disrupted Material Supply Chains, Availability and Lead Times
 - Decreased Labor Productivity
 - Postponed Numerous Construction Projects in 2020
 - 2021 Construction Market Conditions
 - ➤ Demand is Exceeding Capacity; Pushing Local Market Capacity for HVAC and Electrical to Limits; Potential Limits of Local Low-Voltage Market Capacity
 - ➤ Significant Material and Labor Cost Increases
 - o Scope of Technology/Infrastructure Projects Have Been Clearly Defined



Goals of the Mid-Program Reset:

- Demonstrate that the Program Can be Finished with Available Funds
- Develop "Re-Calculated" Budgets and Schedules for Remaining Project Completions
- Present Solutions for Challenging Issues



Approach:

- Review Projects According to Risk Profile -
 - High Risk HHIMS and Technology/Infrastructure Projects
 - Medium Risk RSIA and Larger Scope Athletic Projects Such as Field Houses
 - Low Risk Playgrounds and Safety/Security Projects
- HHIMS Receive and Review SD Estimate from Thompson Turner Construction
- Technology/Infrastructure Evaluate Remaining Future Project Budgets Using Current \$/SF and \$/CR as Revised Cost Models
- RSIA is Viewed as a Medium Risk w/ Final Stages of GMP Negotiations Taking Place;
 GMP (w/o Athletic Fields and Concession Building) is scheduled to receive Board approval in August; Plan is to award a Future GMP for Athletic Fields and Concessions Building Prior to Completing Replacement Campus Construction Using Unused Project Construction Contingency and Program Level Contingency (as needed)



Approach (Continued):

- Athletic Projects Maintain Equality and Work with Schools to Align Scope with Budget
- Playgrounds Scope Not To Exceed Budget
- Safety/Security Work with Schools to Align Scope with Budget
- Tweak Project Schedules to Allow Designs to Start Sooner and to Allow Longer Construction Durations
- Include Adjustments for Inflationary Budget Pressure for Later Projects
- Continue to Monitor Program Level Contingency and Project Level Construction Contingencies
- Close-out Projects and Sweep Leftover Funds to Program Level Contingency ASAP
