This surety shall be forfeited by the bidder in the event of failure to fulfill provisions of bid on which purchase order is based. Personal or Company checks will not be accepted. **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

**CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT:**

Notice, conditions, and specifications issued incident to the proposal to purchase lunch tables described herein, together with the purchase policies of School District No. 25, on file for examination in the office of the Director of Business Operations shall form a part of the contract conditions.

**NATURE OF CONTRACT:**

Explicit Specifications are for the purposes of matching established equipment. All vendors are open to bid specified lunch tables from the specified manufacturer. No substitutions permitted.

Contracts for purchase will be put into effect by means of a purchase order executed by the Director of Business Operations after tabulations are compiled.

**RESPONSIBILITY OF VENDOR:**

Vendor shall be responsible for the delivery of materials of such quality and in specified quantity. The failure to adhere to accepted proposal will be deemed sufficient reason for forfeiting the five percent (5%) deposit or bidder's bond. The bidder shall submit his bid on the proposal form furnished and shall plainly mark on the envelope:

BIDS NOT DELIVERED BY VENDOR AT TIME OF BID OPENING MUST BE RECEIVED IN MAIL NO LATER THAN 4:00 PM ON March 9, 2016, THE DAY BEFORE THE BID OPENING.

**INTERPRETATIONS:**

Should a bidder find discrepancies in or omissions from the specifications, or be in doubt as to their meaning, they should at once notify the Owner, who will send written instructions or addenda to all bidders. The owner will not be responsible for oral interpretations. Questions received less than 48 hours before time for the bid opening cannot be answered. All addenda issued during the time of bidding will be incorporated in the contract.

**DISTRICT REPRESENTATIVE:**

**PAYMENTS:**

Application for Payment dated on or before the 25<sup>th</sup> of the month, shall be paid by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the following month. Application for payment dated after the 25<sup>th</sup> of the month, shall be paid within 30 days.

**BID GUARANTEE:**

As a guarantee that, if awarded the contract, the bidder will execute same and furnish bond. Each bid will be accompanied by a Certified check, Cashier's Check, or Bid Bond for not less than five percent (5%) of the base bid payable to the Owner. NO PERSONAL OR COMPANY CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

**OBJECTIONS:**

Written objections to specifications or bid procedures must be received by the clerk, secretary, or other authorized official of the District at least one (1) business day before the date and time upon which bids are scheduled to be received, per Idaho Code Section 68-2806(c).

**WARRANTY:**

Manufacturer shall warrant products under normal use and service to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for a period of at least 15 years from date of delivery.

Warranty shall cover repair or replacement of such parts determined defective upon inspection.

Warranty does not cover any product or part of a product subject to accident, negligence, alteration, abuse or misuse.

Warranty does not cover any accessories or parts not supplied by the manufacturer.

Warranty shall not cover any labor expended or materials used to repair any equipment without manufacturer's prior written authorization.

**BIDDER'S RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Bid quotations must be supplied on the attached Bid Quotation Forms.

Deliver materials in manufacturer's original, unopened, undamaged containers with identification labels intact.

## **SPECIFICATIONS FOR STANDARD WALL-MOUNTED TABLE AND BENCH SYSTEMS**

### 1. General Description:

- A. Folding tables and bench seats with integral wall pockets with united understructure not requiring the tops of benches for operation.
- B. Bench undercarriage shall be able to support 200 lb. At any point when top panels are removed.

- 1. Tabletop frame shall consist of dual 1.25" x 2.125" (32 x 54 mm) 18 gauge steel box channels; bench frame shall consist of dual 1.5" (38mm) 16 gage steel angle with returned edges rolled to 11 gauge.
- 2. Tubular Members: 16 gauge, 1" (25.4 mm) diameter steel tubing. Center leg assembly outer telescoping tube shall be 16 gauge. 1.375" (35mm) diameter steel tubing; center leg assembly inner telescoping tube shall be 18 gauge, 1.125" (29mm) diameter steel tubing

  - (e) Tables and benches shall have two sets of .5" diameter, solid steel lock bolts. One set of pins is manually activated by means of a remote handle positions near the center of each table and bench. The second set of pins automatically engage while closing the table and bench.
  - (f) Tables and benches shall have field adjustable down latches.

10. Anchor Holes: Provide at base and back of pocket for fastening unit to floors and walls.
