STUDENT SCHOOL BOARD REPRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- 1. Student candidates for the Board will follow the same nomination process as candidates for the Student Council and Class Officer positions.
- 2. Every May, a member of the incoming Junior class will be elected to a two (2) year term, by a vote of Scarborough High School student government, including Student Council and class officers. This election will be organized by the current student School Board Representative with assistance by Building Administration, the Student Council, and class officers. The newly elected member will be seated at the first Board meeting in June.
- 3. All students who submit nomination sheets for a Student School Board seat must attend an informational meeting organized by the current student School Board Representative and including the Student Council, class officers, and may also include Board of Education representatives and the Superintendent of schools.
- 4. Student representatives will follow the same Code of Ethics as other Board members pursuant to Policy BCA.
