FAMILY ACCESS TO THE AL IRFAN CAMPUS





AL IRFAN MOVE FOR HIGH SCHOOL

Grades 9-11 will begin lessons at the new Al Irfan campus on Monday 25th April (online learning on Sunday 24th). The MYP Onscreen examinations (Grade 10) and the DP examinations (Grade 12) will be held at our current, Al Khuwair campus.

SCHOOL DAY

Until the summer the timings for the day will be slightly different, the daily schedule can be accessed from <u>HERE</u>. Students will be permitted to enter the campus from 7:30am and must be in mentor classes by 7:50am.

Students arriving after 7:50am must sign in late at Reception. This is also where students can sign out if permitted to do so during the day. High School students must use the two middle entrances into the main block to enter the campus.

Students will follow the same timetable but rooms will obviously change once on the new campus. Students can view the rooms being used by High School <u>HERE</u>. If unclear then students should check with their Learning Mentor and or classroom teacher.

ORIENTATION



Periods 1 and 2 on Monday 25th April will be used for student orientation with Learning Mentors. Students must meet in their mentor class by 7:50am (double check with your mentor that you know where to meet). This will include a campus tour and the sharing of key information including evacuation routes, location of the nurse, where to go at break time etc.




LUNCH

Students will have access to the cafeteria during both breaks. They can eat a packed lunch in the cafeteria or purchase from the caterers. If students already have a COMO card they may continue to use this on the new campus. Next week, high school students can top-up/ purchase COMO cards from 7:30am to 15:30 pm everyday.



There is Wi-Fi available throughout the campus; the password will be shared with you when you are at the Al Irfan campus.



LIBRARY

The library is a shared K-12 learning space and all students must be respectful of this. The library is open to High School students between 7:30am and 3:15pm (after Ramadan this will extend to 4:00pm). Within the library there is a separate Diploma study room which is for silent/independent study.

LOCKERS

There are enough lockers for all students on the 2nd floor. These are not lockable but can be used to temporarily store items (not valuables). Further information will come from Learning Mentors.

STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

The Student Support Services area is on the 1st floor (around from the library) and this is where students can find social and emotional counselling, university counselling, learning support, English language support and help with using IT for learning (Ejaz IT support is also on the 1st floor but in a different location). Mr Essex is also in this area to provide students with support as needed.





Naturally it will take some time to settle into our new ABA home. Students and parents are encouraged to reach out to Learning Mentors if you have any questions or feedback during those first few days. We are all here to help and will do our best to help students settle quickly.


