The Scarborough School Department recognizes that diagnosed allergies and sensitivities may pose a significant threat to the health of some students and is committed to ensuring that students, parents, staff and medical personnel all work together to minimize risks and foster a safe educational environment for allergies and sensitivities. The health services staff are responsible for developing protocols designed to minimize risk and promote a safe educational environment for those students with allergies and sensitivities. These protocols will identify the responsibilities of the student, the parents, and school staff, and will reflect best practices for mitigating risk. The protocols will be reviewed annually and will be posted publicly on the Scarborough School Department's website in the Health Services/Wellness section.
