

FUNDRAISING

- 1.0 The Board of Education believes that certain fundraising events can be valuable learning experiences for students promoting school spirit and hard work toward the attainment of goals. Therefore, fundraising for educational related projects is permitted and the several building administrators are authorized to approve and are responsible for supervising such activities in the name of the Scarborough School Department and the Town of Scarborough pursuant to this policy and the accompanying regulations.
- 2.0 The Board of Education establishes educational programs for students enrolled in the Scarborough Public Schools and provides adequate funding for those programs. Fundraising goals, therefore, must be specifically for activities for students which are not part of the basic program provided and funded by the Board.
- 3.0 All fundraising events conducted by students and/or parents shall be for specific goals as determined by the students and staff with the approval of the appropriate administrator. The school department shall act as custodians for funds so raised and expend them exclusively for the stated goal of the fundraising project.
- 4.0 Fundraising activities shall not interfere with students' obligations of homework and study and no fundraising will be carried on during instructional hours. The Board shall be informed of all approved student fundraising projects.
