- 2. Guest speaker: Mike Ciavaglia, Lead Mentor for the Divine Child FIRST Robotics Team, Robo Falcons
  - a. The team was formed three years ago. Meetings are held at St. Sabina. Currently there are 12 students on the team, and a lot of good adult support from the DC family.
  - b. As part of the For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology (FIRST), there are opportunities with building robotics primarily, but also animation, CAD, community outreach. The program emphasizes problem solving. Students who participate have opportunities for scholarships, recognition, and they can put it on their college applications.
  - c. Plans have begun for a program and STEM curriculum at DC middle school.
