

Covid-19 Policy

In an effort to help ensure the best for all, the School has the following COVID-19 mitigation measures in place:

- 1. Completion of a full vaccination series and the COVID-19 booster. Proof of vaccination is required.**
- 2. Adherence to state, local, and School guidelines, which will continue to be communicated leading up to Alumni Weekend.**

The Lawrenceville School requires all adults, and children over 5, to be fully vaccinated* against COVID-19 to attend in-person, on-campus Alumni Weekend activities. Before you arrive on campus for Alumni Weekend, you will be asked to provide proof of vaccination status via Cvent, a third-party health clearance site powered by ID.me.

On the Cvent site you will agree to The Lawrenceville School's COVID-19 guidelines, complete the vaccine verification process, and upload your vaccination document. Once completed, you'll receive an email with verification that you are cleared to attend. Registrants will be given instructions and a specific link to Cvent as part of the School's Alumni Weekend communications.

The Lawrenceville School's campus is currently mask-optional for both indoor and outdoor activities. Masking is a personal choice. We expect all community members and visitors to respect the individual choices of others while on campus.

Also, all will be asked to agree to the following COVID-19 policies and guidelines at point of registration:

- By registering for The Lawrenceville School's Alumni Weekend, I agree that I will carefully review and, during the event and all event-related activities, comply with all applicable COVID-19-related federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and guidance, as well as any protocols or practices of The Lawrenceville School.
- I acknowledge that The Lawrenceville School cannot guarantee that attendees will not be exposed to or contract COVID-19 while attending Alumni Weekend, and that by attending they may be exposing or increasing their risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19.
- I understand that The Lawrenceville School will continue to closely monitor conditions related to COVID-19 between now and the start of Alumni Weekend and that the School reserves the right to modify its COVID-19 related procedures and health screening protocols at its sole discretion at any time. Registrants will be informed of any such changes. As a condition of attendance and participation, I agree to follow the protocols as required by The Lawrenceville School. Refusal to abide by The Lawrenceville School's COVID-19 related procedures may result in ejection from campus and cancellation of their registration.

* Effective January 31, 2022, The Lawrenceville School requires all eligible individuals to get a booster shot in order to be considered fully vaccinated. Persons who are not yet eligible for a booster shot but who have received their primary series of vaccination shots will be considered fully vaccinated. This decision is consistent with the CDC's strong recommendation that eligible individuals receive the full COVID-19 dose and the booster and supports our commitment to the best for all.
