Crean Lutheran High School values modest, professional dress. Student appearances should be well kept and nicely groomed. Students are required to be in uniform at all times while on campus. School colors are navy blue, yellow, white, and grey. Our full Dress Code Policy can be found in our <u>Parent & Student Handbook</u>.

TOPS

- Collared CLHS polo shirt or approved sweatshirt must be worn at all times
- Undershirts must be a school color and have no visible writing or design
- Jackets/sweatshirts must have a CLHS logo or be a solid school color and should be appropriately sized

BOTTOMS

- Pants, shorts, or skirts must be khaki, navy blue, or grey. Skirts may also be CLHS plaid. Black bottoms are not permitted.
- Skirts and shorts must be no shorter than fingertip length
- Leggings can be worn under skirts
- Athletic pants, joggers, and sweats are not permitted

FOOTWEAR

- Comfortable, safe, and closed-toed
- No slides, Crocs, slippers, or flip-flops
- Boots must stop below the knee
- Patterned socks are permitted as long as they are not inappropriate or offensive

ACCESSORIES

- CLHS or solid school color hats/beanies are allowed but may not be worn indoors
- Piercings are allowed only in the ears
- For boys, hair style must be neat and no longer than collar length
- Hair must be a natural color

SPIRIT DAYS

Every Friday, students are permitted to wear a Crean Lutheran shirt with approved uniform bottoms.

- Shirts must have Crean Lutheran branding on it and cannot be modified or altered
- Tournament or competition shirts without Crean Lutheran branding are not permitted

THEME DAYS

Themed dress days occur throughout the year. Non-uniform dress guidelines must be followed. Outfit must align with the designated theme.

"Jeans for Jesus" days occur once a month to raise money for different causes. Students wear jeans with a Crean Lutheran shirt. Jeans cannot be ripped or frayed.

Students who do not follow the dress code guidelines will receive a dress code violation and may be asked to change into an appropriate item from our uniform closet or be sent home to change. Multiple violations will result in further consequences.
