Please note the following:

- All students who are testing should report to school at normal time.
- All students who are not testing should report to school on a 3 hour delay. Transportation will be provided for bus students.
- All-Day LCTI students (Academic Center and CAP) will follow a normal schedule in reporting to LCTI. All-Day LCTI students will be taking Keystone Exams at LCTI during the LCTI Keystone Exam schedule.
- AM LCTI students will report to PHS at normal time.
 - Students who are testing will take their exams and then report to the gym bleachers where they will be “housed” until 12:26 P.M. They will eat lunch 5th period.
 - Students who are not testing will go to LCTI at normal time. They will depart from LCTI to return to PHS at normal time. Upon return, they will report to the gym bleachers and be “housed” until 12:54 P.M.
- PM LCTI students will report to school at appropriate times based on if they are testing or not. Bagged lunches will be available and they can eat at designated tables in the cafeteria during 2nd period. Departure to LCTI will be at normal time -11:24. They are excused from 2nd - 4th periods.
- All late arrival and early dismissal privileges will remain in effect during testing days but will follow the modified schedule.
- Students with DCO will be excused at the students' normal time to fulfill work requirements. They will be excused from the periods that they will miss due to the modified schedule.
- Breakfast will be available before 7:40 AM and before 10:40 AM arrivals
