The board unanimously approved the meeting minutes from the February 17, 2022 board meeting.

REPORTS:

Executive Director's Report:

Thomas McGregor reported he and Principal Brandy Osborn provided an update about their annual review to the Roseburg Public School Board on February 23, 2022. The team received clear feedback from majority of the directors to improve volume of students receiving interim testing annually. Phoenix leadership will return to the Roseburg Public School Board in late April's meeting to provide a quick insight on the activity in the school community.

Summer 2022 programming is still in development, offerings may focus more on independent learning options or short duration mini camps focused on CTE areas or art/music. Faculty returning to practice of, summer as a chance for rest, is the overall sentiment at Phoenix.

Principal's Report:

Enrollment: Brandy reported that our current enrollment is 191 students as of March 17th, 2022. We currently have five students on the waitlist and are working to bring back students who have left us.

2021-22 School Year Operations: Brandy shared that our attendance rate has maintained, in January, February and March, it was around 55% to 57%. Beginning to see an increase in students who recently dropped out re-enrolling to continue their education.

Brandy also shared that continued natural shifts are occurring with students reporting intolerance as a student body. Brandy shared an article with key points targeting violence towards educators and school staff during the pandemic.

Bid has been put on purchasing vape detection devices with a corporation that works with our copier leasing contract.
