CHARLES COUNTY REQUIREMENTS FOR A MARYLAND HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA

To be awarded a diploma, a student shall be enrolled in Charles County Public Schools (CCPS) and have earned a minimum of 23 credits that include the following:

Making Your Options Come True: Grades!!!!!!

- ☐ Your Junior **Transcript** is very important
- ☐ **Why?**
- ☐ Answer – It's the first look that colleges have of your academic performance
- ☐ GPA- Weighted & Unweighted
- ☐ Class Rank
- ☐ Classes Taken



Transcript(s) Request Form

- ☐ If you are not using an online admissions platform discussed transcripts must be picked up from counselor
- ☐ Mail your transcript to the requesting college
- ☐ Follow-up with counselors & colleges within 2-3 weeks

NORTH POINT HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT REQUEST FORM

Student must give the counseling office a minimum of **five school days** to complete their transcript and/or letter of recommendation request(s). It is the student's responsibility to pick up the requested documentation from the main office.

Transcript request forms are available for pick up in the main office or can be downloaded from the school website (www.ccboe.com/northpoint - click on "departments" then "career center"). Payment should be made at the time of request (\$2.00 cash only/per request, exact change please – checks will **not** be accepted). Summer Instructions: Please place monies in a sealed envelope with student's name, date, telephone number, counselor's name and additional forms, if applicable.
