- All graduation requirements must be achieved. If you have any cause for concern, we
 recommend that you or your son (immediately) contact the Servite High School counseling
 department. Graduation requirements include academic coursework, service hours,
 attendance, discipline, and tuition billing. Failure to successfully complete these will prevent
 a student from graduating and may preclude him from participating in Senior Week events.
- Students are to attend each scheduled class through the rest of the school year. Should students choose to miss or disrupt class time, they will be subjected to all discipline and attendance policies.
- Vandalism on or off-campus will be referred to the appropriate law enforcement agency. If your son participates in vandalism, he may be removed from the commencement exercise and expelled from school.
- All policies in the Servite student-parent handbook will be enforced.

As principal, my goal is to proactively and faithful encourage the best and proper student behaviors. Do not do anything that would belittle, tarnish, or ruin your and the school's reputation. We do not want any actions to detract from the celebration and achievements of the Class of 2022.
