

Roden advised that based on the Constitution, Law enforcement have limited rights in that respect. This would mean additional costs to the community and take a lot of time if additional school staff were added to do the searches.

Ms. Van Aken requested an inventory of door magnets be done with the help of the SROs and to purchase quantities necessary.
