Distinguished Scholar (DS)

Distinguished Scholars MUST fulfill all of the CLASSICAL requirements PLUS:

- Complete **240 - 280 credits** with an **unweighted academic grade point average of 3.3** by end of 7th semester
- Earn **no Ds or Fs at any semester grading period**
- Have no **Honor Code violations**
- Complete at least **3 Advanced Placement (AP)** classes
- Take **accelerated, honors or AP level** classes in English (3 of 4 years), History and Science (except Physics and Biotechnology)
- Eligible to take 7 classes per year; **college prep (A-G) electives recommended**
- Complete **40 hours of Service to Community by May of senior year**

Wilson's Academic Vision of Excellence (WAVE)

WAVE students must fulfill all of the above requirements PLUS:

- Take **7 classes** each year, including **4 years each** of English, Math, Science and World Language (*same language all 4 years*)
- Complete at least **5 Advanced Placement (AP)** classes (WAVE students entering with a 3.8 or higher GPA will take one AP course in the freshman year.)
- Maintain a **3.3 academic grade point average** each school year
- Complete **280 credits** with a **total unweighted academic grade point average of 3.5** by the end of the 7th semester of high school
- Complete **80 hours of Service to Community by May of senior year**

Dual Immersion (DI)

Dual Immersion students must fulfill the following requirements:

- Complete 4 years of Spanish Language and 2 years of Social Studies in Spanish Language
- DI students may be concurrently enrolled in Classical, DS or WAVE programs
- Receive a Seal of Biliteracy from the State of California
