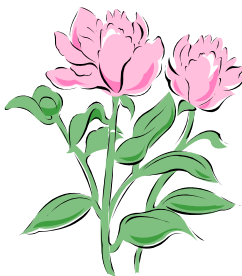


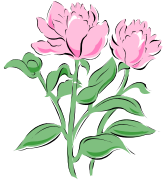
# MAY DAY AT A GLANCE

## PRE-KINDERGARTEN

- May Day is Thursday, April 28 (rain date is April 29) at 1:30 p.m. on the Wornall Field Hockey Field. Seating is limited. You may want to come early and bring your own lawn chair. Parking along 50<sup>th</sup> & 51<sup>st</sup> streets (where the No Parking signs are covered) is allowed. Please observe all other parking regulations.
- Pre-Kindergartners will sit on the northwest corner of the field.
- Pre-Kindergartners will skip across the field and present flowers to the May Queen.
- **\*\*\*Parent responsibility: Please send your child to school on May Day with a small bunch (about 4-6 stems) of flowers out of your garden or purchased. The flowers will be assembled into individual bouquets for each pre-kindergartner to present to the May Queen.**
