**TITLE I PARENT INVOLVEMENT POLICY**

The Mustang School District's Title I program encourages each Title I parent to be involved in their child's education. This policy outlines the parent involvement activities that will be conducted during the school year.

- ❖ Parents will receive a copy of the Parent Involvement Policy which describes the ongoing activities held throughout the year to inform and involve parents in your child's education.
- ❖ Parents will receive a copy of the Family-School Compact which is an agreement between the family and school outlining everyone's responsibility for supporting student learning.
- ❖ A Title I annual parent meeting will be held; the date and time of the meeting will be announced at each Title I site and posted on the Title I website. This meeting will give parents the opportunity to actively participate and have input into the Title I program. This meeting will also cover:
  - The results of the annual review meeting from the previous spring
  - How students are selected to be in the Title I program
  - In what activities students will be involved
  - How students will be assessed to determine growth
  - How and when the assessment information will be sent home
- ❖ Suggestions and strategies for working with your child, lists of good books to read to/with your child, as well as other information, will be sent home periodically to inform parents how to help students succeed at school. Parent resources are also available on district and teacher websites.
- ❖ Parent-teacher conferences are scheduled twice yearly, fall and spring. The Title I teachers are available to review student's progress and answer any questions you may have.
- ❖ Each spring, a survey is distributed to Title I parents which offers parents the opportunity to provide feedback on program services, teachers, etc. We look forward to suggestions and/or recommendations from parents to help with making improvements to the Title I program.
- ❖ We invite you to contact the school or Title I teachers with questions or to request a meeting. It is our hope the students have a wonderful learning experience in the Title I program.
