CLOC 2021 Year End Report



- CLOC members spent over 500 hours in 2021 reviewing projects
- \$93.9 million spent (as of 12-31-2021) out of \$344 million
- Analysis indicates remaining referendum projects can be completed without exceeding total referendum budget
- Highlights of Accomplishments through end of December 2021
 - Completion of New Addition at May River HS and New Additions at River Ridge Academy
 - Completion of Referendum projects at Lady's Island MS and Right Choices
 - Completion of Safety/Security Building Improvements at 12 schools
 - Completion of Athletic improvements at 7 schools
 - Completion of Playground improvements at 12 schools
 - Construction has commenced at Robert Smalls International Academy (GMP \$61.7 million) and Battery Creek HS (GMP \$49.5 million)
 - Renovations for Beaufort Elementary are nearing completion







- The dollars spent and encumbered did not exceed the budgeted project total.
- The dollars spent per project did not exceed the estimated project percent completed.
- Material and Construction Cost continues to challenge cost control and schedule
