The OLGC Lenten Fish Fry Recap:

A huge thank you to all who supported the OLGC Lenten Fish Fry this year as a participant and/or a volunteer. This event is first and foremost about strengthening the OLGC parish community. There is no doubt that OLGC is a really special place with great people. How many of us met someone new by attending the event or through volunteering? How awesome was it watching the youth working during the event or seeing kids playing with friends outside? People around Vienna and across other parishes started noticing the exceptionality of our parish community. Many asked, so here are some key numbers from the event this year, none of which would have been possible without the support and efforts of so many people:

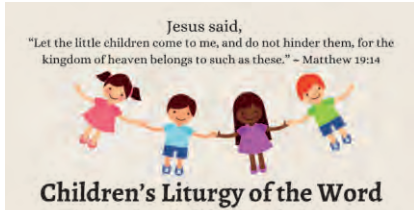
- More than 250 individuals volunteered (ranging in age from 7 to 87). Many volunteered multiple times.
- 5,701 seafood entrees were served, including 1,129 on April 8th.
- The top 3 seafood entrees included:
 - Fried Fish – 1,189
 - Shrimp – 1,047
 - 'Metzger' Fish/Shrimp combo – 783
- French fries were the #1 selling item – 2,247 orders
- Coleslaw (1,311), Mac & Cheese (854) and Rice & Beans (792) were also popular sides
- 2,400 pounds of Cod, 680 pounds of shrimp, and 35 gallons of oysters were used
- 2,750 pounds of potatoes were made into fries
- ??? gallons of mayonnaise (you really don't want to know)
- Over 400 servings of wine
- Over 1,250 servings of beer
- Over 1,750 drinks (water/soda/juice) served
- The dessert table was filled every week with delicious homemade desserts - 1,282 orders

While the amount of profit still needs to be determined, but the event was very successful and we thank you for your support. Looking ahead to next year, Ash Wednesday is February 22, 2023, so the next fish fry will be February 24, 2023.

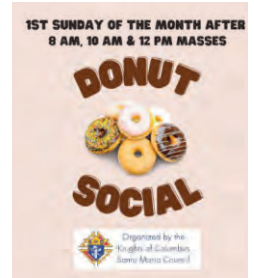

The Laudato Si Animators Program is made up of webinars, readings, and videos. There are hundreds of others, from different continents, taking this course.

- Learn the concepts of Laudato Si, and how it fits into Catholic social teaching's principles of human dignity, common good, and solidarity.
- Understand the causes and consequences of climate change - how the unfairness and injustice of this crisis affects the earth and the poor.
- See how you are connected to the situation, examples of how others are bringing Laudato Si to life, and a connection to a global movement.
- Practice the skill of putting together an event or activity for their community, talking with others about Laudato Si, and have a chance to reflect on that learning.
- Connect to your own calling to bring Laudato Si to life - a sense of your own path for carrying out actions in light of our faith to care for creation. See how your own faith connects with the moral duty to address the climate crisis.
- Dedicate yourself to ongoing personal ecological conversion, so that your heart and eyes are open to cry of the earth and the poor and you are called into deeper action. Our Animators are eager for ongoing involvement with LSM, whether by building a chapter, a circle, involvement in Laudato Si Generation, or otherwise supporting our common mission.

World Vision Global 6K for Water Sat. May 21 at 9am: Together let's walk in response to the cry of the poor in the farthest reaches of our planet.

6 kilometers is the average distance people in the developing world walk for water every day - water often contaminated with life-threatening disease. The time-consuming job is usually left to women and children (primarily girls), preventing them from access to education. One of the goals of Pope Francis' encyclical letter, Laudato Si', is a call to respond to the Cry of the Poor, paying special attention to vulnerable groups. On Saturday, May 21, thousands around the world will walk or run 6 kilometers to bring life-changing clean water to communities in need. A Vienna team will gather on the Vienna Town Green at 9am and walk together to support the cause. PAYMENT SCAMS ARE ON THE RISE – Here are three tips to help protect yourself against this fresh scam. First of all, guard your information. Don't share your temporary access code, PIN, or any other account information which could give others a way to send money in your name. Secondly, don't rely on caller ID. Scammers can make it look like they're contacting you from your bank or another company. If you're suspicious about a call or text, hang up or don't respond. Reach out to the bank or company

directly using a trusted source such as their website or the phone number on the back of your credit card. Lastly, question unusual payment requests. Scammers often demand very specific forms of payment. Don't be pressured into using gift cards, cryptocurrency, online wires, Zelle, or third-party payment apps. No legitimate company will ask you to send money to anyone, including yourself, to correct a problem or get a refund.

The goal here is to catch the scam before it catches you. Scammers are trying everything they can to trick you into giving them money. I continue to receive e-mails that look like invoices, thanking me for purchasing security protection for my computer from Norton (usually) and paying with my PayPal account (which I don't have) along with the amount (usually around \$500). I'm also advised that if I didn't make this purchase, I should call a certain number (which I never do). The sender's address is always one ending in gmail.com. I immediately delete such mails. It's sad to know that seniors are the ones being targeted more than anyone else. Research shows that folks in this group experience loneliness more often than others and are more easily duped because of that. Don't be afraid; be alert. There's nothing wrong with hanging up or deleting a suspicious e-mail or text.

EASIER MEDICARE ENROLLMENT? – There's a bill before Congress that aims to lessen the burden on seniors who enroll in Medicare. The proposal would ensure that people approaching their 65th birthday are notified well in advance of their eligibility for Medicare and are given clear information about enrollment rules for Part B with the goal of minimizing costly errors. In 2020, more than 760,000 people paid a late enrollment penalty, resulting in an increased monthly premium by 27%.
