PAT PROCESS OVERVIEW Project / Process Status Update





New Memorial Drive Elementary School – Project Scope

- **Replacement of Memorial Drive Elementary School** with new building and site elements
- **Approx. 88,000 SF** building per SBISD Educational Specifications
- **Off Site Transition:** Campus will relocate to South Transition Campus from January 2023 thru May 2024
- **18-20 months** total construction period
- **August 2024 = New MDE opens**



PAT Engagement – Project Advisory Team (PAT) Charge

OVERVIEW

A Project Advisory Team (PAT) will be chartered for the planning of a replacement for **Memorial Drive Elementary School** under the school's project in the 2017 Bond Program.

CHARGE

The PAT will work collaboratively and cooperatively with the architect and SBISD Project Manager **to conceptualize, develop and refine the project's goals and design.**

The PAT will advise on recommendations regarding the interior and exterior appearance of the replacement of Memorial Drive Elementary School.

The PAT will reach a proposed recommendation through consensus.

These recommendations will be presented to the Superintendent + Board of Trustees for approval. *The Board of Trustees may act upon the recommendations developed with PAT input by approving, amending, altering or not approving all or any part of the recommendations.*






