- Teacher Student Success Plan 2022-2023 Proposal:
 - Unanimous approval

Connie Stanger question – Is there a possibility of different core teachers other than math, be available after school for Homework Helps?

- Mr Jackman has not ever had an instance of there being a strong need in previous schools but is willing to look at this option if desired. Typically, math is the area with the greatest need for tutoring help.
- Building Update
 - Meetings are more frequent now
 - Building will be able to handle 1200 students

Connie Stanger concerns – she said that she would not be willing to vote in favor of Sunset if West Point gets bumped up in place of our school.

- Our current population is 920 and the district has only provided for 300 more students. This is based on data from 5 years ago. The prediction is that we will have more than 1200 students 10 years from now.
- She also suggested that a way to change perceptions of Sunset Jr High we might consider changing the name of the school to represent all communities.
