What is eStart? eStart is an online dual credit program, offered through the Community College System of NH, that enables high school students to take community college courses for dual high school AND college credit.



Who is eligible to take an eStart course? Sophomores, Juniors or Seniors.

When do the courses run? Fall & Spring semesters. The spring semester dates are January 18 - May 6, 2022

What is the cost? \$150 per course + textbooks, however, STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering & Math) and CTE (Career Technical Education) courses are free.

Are courses in-person or online? Courses offered through the eStart program are 100% online college courses.

Rotary - SHORT TERM YOUTH EXCHANGE

For Students Ages 15 - 18 1/2

What is Short Term Exchange? Participating students live with a matched student and host family in their selected country from three to six weeks in the summer, under the sponsorship of the Meredith Rotary Club. The exchange in each country is for an equal amount of time. You spend 3 weeks or more with a family in your chosen country – then that student returns with you and spends the same amount of time with your family, or vice versa. Though speaking the language is a plus – for the Short Term program it is not a requirement.

Hear about the Short-Term exchange program from Isabel Dube who spent the summer of 2019 in France. “My Rotary Short Term Exchange was something that I will definitely remember for the rest of my life. Even though it was only for a short time of my life, I now have friends in another country and amazing memories from every day I was in Europe. Going to live with a new family was a completely new experience for me that got me out of my comfort zone for a whole month. I am so glad that my correspondent ended up being an amazing girl that I got to spend two months with while traveling around Europe, and showing her where I am from. I am so grateful for everything that I had the opportunity to experience and see for the first time while overseas like Paris, Barcelona, South of France, and other parts of France and Spain.



Grade 8 Specials Second Semester


