The month of April went by quickly! Our classes were very busy both before and after our Spring Break.

The Dinosaur class spent a week studying . . . dinosaurs! They made dinosaur pictures and dinosaur fossils using salt dough. They measure an Apatosaurus and realized that it was too big to fit on our playground! And they found that the entire class could fit in the huge footprint of a Diplodocus!

The 4's classes planted seeds and watched them sprout. They learned that the plants need soil, air and water to grow. They also studied frogs and pond life, Earth Day, and birds and other oviparous animals.

In our Religion classes, we followed Jesus' journey from Palm Sunday through Holy Week, culminating in His glorious resurrection on Easter Sunday. Resurrection Eggs helped us to retell the story.

In Science class at the big school, the children have been learning about the water cycle, air vapor, and clouds. They observed steam rising from hot water (vapor) and went outside to observe the different types of clouds.

All of our students enjoyed a special Easter-themed Creative Movement class. They participated in the Bunny Pokey, an egg relay race, a movement game, and sending "bunny tails" hopping on the parachute!

Right before Spring Break, each class enjoyed special Easter games, including the Bunny Hop, sack races, pin the tail on the bunny, and an egg and spoon relay through an obstacle course. The day concluded with an Easter Egg Hunt in the big field.
