By now, you have most likely heard the news that Herron Classical Schools has signed a purchase agreement for the building at 3100 N. Meridian Street as our permanent site. The building was owned by The Children's Museum of Indianapolis. We are thrilled to offer such a central location with world-class neighbors. While we anticipate collaborating with The Children's Museum on special projects, both organizations will remain independent of one another.

Herron Prep will continue to create and implement curriculum, maintain operations, and manage events on the property. As Herron Classical Schools President Janet McNeal said, "This location is truly ideal as it is equidistant to our high school campuses. I can't imagine a better neighbor for the permanent site for Herron Preparatory Academy."

As you are aware, we will remain in the temporary location for the 2022-23 school year with K - grade 3 but will begin renovations soon on the new space to serve K-grade 4 in 2023-24. 




Technology Agreement


