



## Student Google Accounts

### New for 2019-2020:

- ❖ Students currently enrolled K-12 have a NEW Google account.
- ❖ New Google accounts abide by the following naming scheme:
  - Student Email: StudentStateID@normandysc.org
  - Student Password: Birthdate (MMDDYYYY) + First Initial + Last Initial (in caps)
    - *Password Example: A student named Sam Jones with a birth-date of September 23, 2007 would have the following password: 09232007SJ*

❖ Note: When emailing/adding students to shared docs/using Google Classroom/etc, you do not have to be concerned with typing student ID numbers. Students' names will be associated with their email accounts, so accounts will auto-populate just as they do when you enter staff names.

### Important Considerations:

- ❖ It is crucial to talk to our students about Digital Citizenship. As such, you are expected to review the following resources and engage your students in age-appropriate and developmentally-appropriate lessons and conversations regarding responsible and safe use of the internet and email.
