## **AP TEST UPDATES**

College Board has provided the following information regarding 2020 AP Tests:

- Traditional face-to-face exam administrations <u>will not</u> take place. Students will take a 45-minute online free-response exam at home.
- For updated exam dates and other helpful information visit: https://apcoronavirusupdates.collegeboard.org/students
- In late April, College Board will provide AP students and educators with information on how to access the testing system on test day, and video demonstrations so that students can familiarize themselves with the system.
  - To ensure you are receiving updates from College Board, make sure you registered with an active email account that you check regularly. If you registered with your school issued email (#####LastName@mustangps.org), you will not receive updates. You will need to update your information with College Board with a personal email account.

## **AP Exam Cancellation:**

Students will have the option to cancel their exams and receive a full refund.

The <u>deadline</u> to request an exam cancellation is **APRIL 30, 2020**.

To cancel an exam:

- 3. Select the exam(s) you wish to cancel and select "next"
- 4. Select "Send Cancellation Request"
