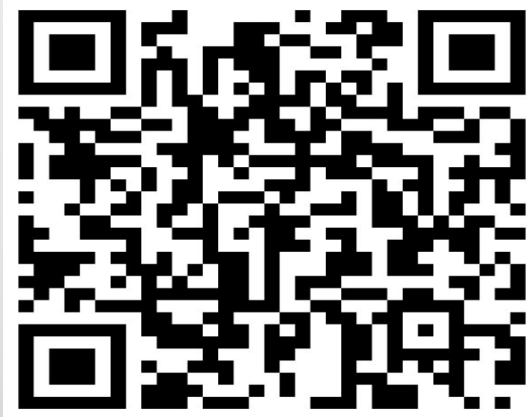

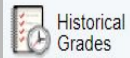

Schedule Changes
