

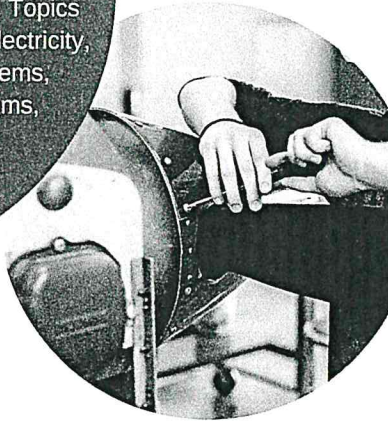

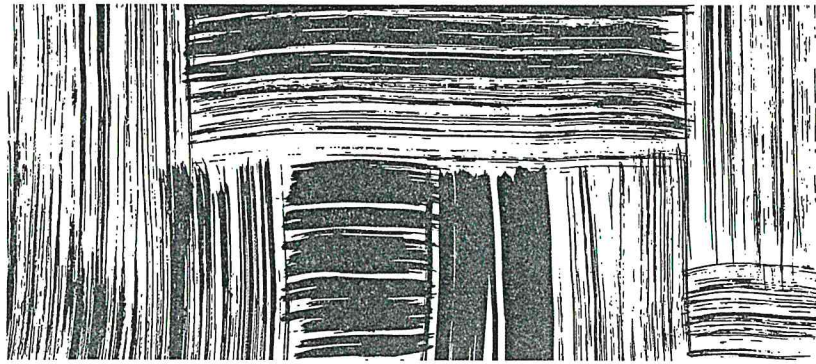
AVIATION MAINTENANCE
