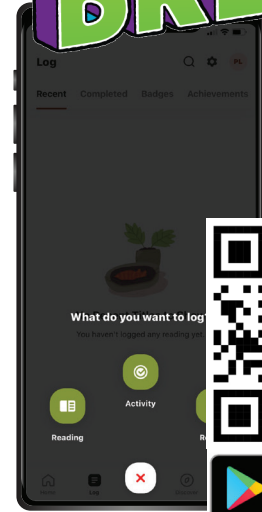


Storytime in the Garden with Author Sarah Nelson

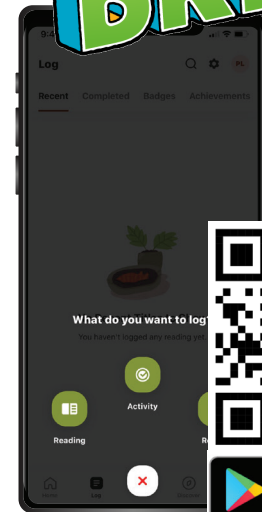
