## MINUTES

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### 17-259 Call Meeting to Order

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A motion was made by Mrs. Jamison to call the meeting to order at 4:30. 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### 17-260 Approve Minutes from March 19, 2019 Meeting.

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A motion was made by LaShawna Barnett to approve the minutes from the March 19, 2019 meeting and was seconded by Jennifer Coyle.

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### 17-261 FRC

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Gloria shared yearly updates for the Family Resource Program. She shared the many programs FRC is involved in and the way that FRC supports our students, families, and community. FRC provides food for the backpack program for 29 kids- 4 kids recently moved. Money donations from Owingsville Bank, Farm Bureau, and money left from an estate. Sam's Club has also been delivering food every week for backpack program that includes a fruit, snack, beanie weenie can, and FRC adds a vegetable, cereal, etc. The donations have allowed FRC to give more food to families that are in need. Gloria shared about Children's Incorporated program and the donations provided by the foundation. FRC is able to buy items for sponsored children throughout the year including back to school clothing, supplies, Christmas gifts, winter clothing, and spring clothing. FRC provides extra clothing to students in need from donations, and also buys new shoes and clothing for students to keep if needed. FRC sponsors popcorn, snow cones, etc throughout the year for school events. FRC is sponsoring blow up end of the year inflatables this year around \$600.00. FRC will do home visits for permission forms, contacting parents if children are sick, delivering items for Children's incorporated, take food, blankets, heaters to families. Assists with Angel Tree sign ups, wrapping gifts, and delivery of gifts. Assists with educational programs like open house, big smiles dental, watch dog dads, truth or consequences activity, autism awareness event, school supplies for kindergarten readiness, earth day seeds, reading nights, book fair nights, attends many conferences, provides items for AR store.

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### 17-262 Budget Reports

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The SBDM council reviewed and discussed the current financial reports. Sabrina McKenzie made a motion to accept the financial report and Jennifer Coyle seconded the motion.

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### 17-263 Grant Presentation

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Mrs. Lara Little wrote a grant through Tractor Supply in partnership with the High School FFA and was awarded \$5000 to add trees to the landscaping at CES.

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Mrs. Jamison shared success of the STAR program in progress monitoring and assessments. Mrs. Barnett shared the value of the STAR reports in progress monitoring in the classroom and the ease of use in the classroom.
